

Exposed conveyance which is not subject to biosecurity control – request for permission to arrive at a place other than a first point of entry, or to report the unloading of goods

Biosecurity Act 2015

For use by: an operator or person in charge of an exposed conveyance that is not subject to biosecurity control pursuant to subparagraph 6(1)(f)(iii) of the *Biosecurity (Exposed Conveyances – Exceptions from Biosecurity Control) Determination 2016* (Exposed Conveyances Determination) because it is returning from an installation operating under an Approved Arrangement. The conveyance is intended to land or be moored at a place other than a first point of entry in Australian Territory, or intends to unload certain goods in Australian Territory.

This form must be submitted <u>5 working days</u> prior to the arrival of the conveyance in Australian territory to allow time for processing.

- Biosecurity waste must not be unloaded from the conveyance in the absence of a waste service provider operating under an approved arrangement or a direction from a Biosecurity Officer.
- All goods specified in a permission requested under Part B (1) must be presented to a Biosecurity Officer for inspection on arrival.
