Fee for service inspection details

The Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment operates on a fee for service basis and charges will be applicable for inspection of all stalls, prior to movement and cleaning. Further inspection after cleaning and disinfection, if required, at an approved premise, must be carried out under departmental supervision prior to movement back to the airport or release. A fee for re-inspection and supervision of disinfection will also apply.
