The collection of protected information including personal and sensitive information by the Department of Agriculture and Water Resources (the department) in relation to this form is being collected under the *Biosecurity Act 2015* for the purposes of assessing your application to import your cat or dog and related purposes. If the relevant personal information requested in this form is not provided by you, the department may be unable to process your application. Information collected by the Department will only be used or disclosed as authorised under the *Biosecurity Act 2015*. The personal information requested on this form may be disclosed to other Commonwealth or State Agencies. It will usually be disclosed overseas. In every case it will only be disclosed if authorised by the *Biosecurity Act 2015*.
