It is an offence under the *Export Control Act 2020* to fail to comply with a condition of an export licence.

In addition to the information you have provided to complete this form, the Secretary (or delegate) may request further information from you, including (but not limited to) certified copies of relevant documents or further evidence relating to the sourcing and species of the wood intended to be exported.

Giving false or misleading information or a false or misleading document to the Commonwealth is a serious offence under the *Criminal Code Act 1995* (Cth).
