The Mount Eliza Association for Environmental Care strongly urges the following:

- 1. A major national park for the Strzelecki Forest be established (at last), as less than 2% of the bioregion is in formal reserves and the Strzeleckis lack a CAR reserve system.
- 2. Restoration of native forest classification to the areas in the Strzelecki State Forest that have been incorrectly classified as plantation.
- 3. Urgent reservation of the high biodiversity 'Cores and Links' identified in the Strzelecki Ranges Biodiversity Study, as the process of protecting these areas is years behind time.
- 4. The issue of the Government leasing native forest to Hancocks as plantation be reviewed.
