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Privacy Policy

'Personal information' means any information or opinion about an identified, or reasonably identifiable, individual.

The Department collects your personal information for the purpose of assessing and processing your application. The Department is authorised to collect and store this personal information under the Export Control Act 1982 (Cwlth).

If you fail to provide some or all of your personal information, the Department may not be able to process your application.

The Department may disclose your personal information to relevant authorities in an importing country and other Australian agencies, as well as other persons or organisations where necessary for these purposes, provided the disclosure is consistent with the *Privacy Act 1988* and other relevant laws. Your personal information may also be disclosed to relevant employees within your organisation for the purpose of approving your registration and to maintain the currency of your personal information for the purpose of the registration. Your personal information will be used and stored in accordance with the Australian Privacy Principles.

By completing and submitting this form you consent to the collection, use and disclosure of all personal information, including sensitive information, in this form to and by the relevant authorities in the importing country.

The department has not taken steps to ensure that the relevant authorities in the importing country do not breach the Australian Privacy Principles. This means that:

- relevant authorities in the importing country will not be accountable under the Privacy Act
- you will not be able to seek redress under the Privacy Act
